Food for Kidz

Dear Members of the Stewartville Sportsman's Club,

We are excited to extend this invitation for you to become involved in the 20th Annual Kiwanis Food for Kidz food pack Stewartville community service project on April 6, 2024.

The Kiwanis Clubs of Stewartville, Rochester, Winona, Spring Valley and Lake City, along with Stewartville and area High School Kiwanis Key Clubs and Middle School Kiwanis Builders Clubs will host the annual FFK food pack event at the Stewartville Civic Center. After the event, Food For Kidz of Stewart, MN distributes the food packages to areas of the world and United States where children are

starving. More information on their efforts can be found at: www.foodforkidz.org

- **Goal:** In 19 years, over 2.1 million meals have been packed and distributed through the volunteer efforts of many. We want to pack as many meals as we can this year.
- Each of the 8 participating Kiwanis clubs is asked to contribute \$2,000 from their club toward the goal. The Stewartville Club manages to raise more than that each year through their fundraising efforts. The Stewartville community of individuals, families, businesses, charitable groups, Scouts and churches make this event a huge success each year. This year the Stewartville Club hopes to raise at least \$7,500 over the total club goal of \$16,000 so we can match or even surpass last year's total of \$19,908 which made 117,111 meals. The cost of meals has gone up so we have to raise \$23,422 to make that same amount of meals.
- **YOU CAN HELP US:** Please consider a donation toward the cost of ingredients, keeping in mind that each meal costs 20 cents for the ingredients. Each dollar raised makes 5 meals. We can only assemble as many meals as we can raise money for to cover the cost of the ingredients. Any amount donated is appreciated.
- **CALL TO VOLUNTEER:** Consider volunteering for a shift to help pack the food. It takes over 300 volunteers to pack that many meals in 6 short hours. It can be a great team building activity for your members and a wonderful event for your families to help with (ages K and up).!!
