

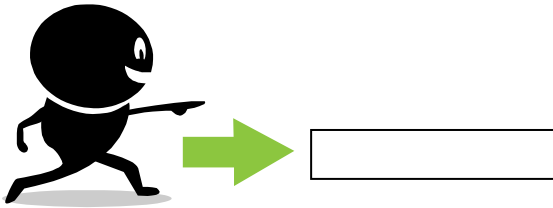

Little history of LFP provided by Barb Hill,

Our Little Free Pantries (LFP) are just over a year old and being well used! We purchase ALL the food for the backpack programs at Bonner, BCI, MS, and HS. We fill each LFP at least once a week. Mine...at S. Hills is often filled 3-5x a week. It is used by over 50 families and homeless people stop later in the evening.

The Food Shelf in Racine is used by 57 families-3 who are homeless. We have dropped off food at Tiger Time and Stewartville Center for Active Adults! I have delivered meals to shut ins.
